Dr. Tolentino, Academic Chief Officer. students a brief orientation of the program, curriculum, and of seven study modules and ATI workbooks, that will be provided to the students. An overview of various clinical facilities that the students will be visiting to gain practical knowledge was provided by our director of nursing.

Most students qualify for federal student loans and Pell grants. Our financial aid administrator helped students fill out FAFSA and receive entrance counseling.

After that, it was time for lunch which was brought in from a nearby restaurant and

enjoyed by everyone. The limousine that brought them to the school now brought them back to Torrance. Nearly everyone who has visited the school has signed up for the program and they're on their way to a very satisfying career in healthcare field.
